The Commission's action was based upon its review of the institution's application for reaccreditation, the on-site visit team reports (visits conducted October 15-16, 2019 and October 17-18, 2019), and the institution's responses to those reports, received November 21, 2019.

The Accrediting Commission commends the institution for its efforts toward meeting the Standards for Accreditation reflected in the on-site evaluation team reports.
